

## Young Workers Committee Report for the period of May 1<sup>st</sup> to July 31<sup>st</sup>

Since the YWC's AGM in January 2019, the executives of this committee were very active in union actions within the region. Our primary focus has been on having strong recruitment, but as the YWC was also intent on supporting other actions/events in the region, we were not able to primarily focus on recruitment as much as we planned to and intend on taking up recruitment as a priority in the Fall/Winter going into 2020.

For this second quarter, we took a step back and strategized on having a strong recruitment drive for September 2019 as more members are back from summer vacations and are at work.

The second priority for YWC will be the Precarious Work campaign, which the committee is currently working on with the PSAC staff from headquarters to receive the required guidance and support to start our campaign as of September.

The Co-Chairs of the YWC, Kevin Hanson and Ayrin Proulx, are also taking representative position at Vanguard (Young Professional Network in PSPC) with a goal to recruit more members by using government resources and government events.
